A huge re-building process was undertaken and the facility re-opened in October 2015, such was the commitment from Dowty's parent company GE to maintain the capability that the facility offers.

Says Dave Jackson, of TT Electronics, "GE recognised that through this difficult period the support of their supply chain was key to continuing to meet their customers' needs and as such held a suppliers day, inviting 15 key suppliers who all received an award for their service and support during this time. Dave Jackson continues, "Dowty is now entering a program to increase production to satisfy the backlog of orders as a result of the fire and as a key supplier of cables. TT Electronics will of course be ready and able to meet this demand."
